SUBJECT: DISTRICT CONVENTION CALL

By virtue of the authority vested in the District Presidents by the Constitution and Bylaws of the American Legion Auxiliary, Department of Texas, for the districts listed on the reverse side, a convention of the respective districts as indicated is hereby called.

The purpose of the convention is to hear the year's reports of each unit, to elect a District President and Vice President of the even numbered districts and to transact such other business as may be properly presented to the convention.

The voting strength of each unit will be based on the 2018 membership transmitted to Department. In the district convention, a unit shall be entitled to two delegates for the first ten members or major fraction thereof, whose current dues have been received in Department Headquarters fifteen days prior to the convening of said convention, and to one alternate for each delegate. The delegates and alternates shall be elected at the regular unit meeting to be held not less than fifteen days before the district convention.

Please send Certification of Delegates to your District President, using the enclosed white form. The pink form is to be retained and brought to the convention by the delegation chairman.

Furnish your District President with a complete list of member's deceased since your last district convention for the Memorial service.

All members of the American Legion Auxiliary are invited. Each unit in the district should send a delegation to the convention. Your cooperation in making this convention a success will be greatly appreciated.
